Call for Applications 2013

Our Tunisian partner universities ENIT, IHEC and ESSEC organized the application process for the second cohort of students for the full-time Master Programme Innovation Management. Starting from May 16th candidates could apply online on the ENIT Website. Graduates from Engineering, Technical and Business Management Schools as well as professionals are welcome to apply for the programme. After the first selection step candidates will see online who passed the first obstacle and is asked to hand in a paper application until June 27th. Selected candidates who also passed the paper application will be invited to an interview which will take place on July 30th and 31st. Admission to the programme will be based on a ranking. Therefore credits will be given for 2 main criteria:



Apply to DICAMP in 2013

- 1: Credits based on the paper application (criteria: average mark of studies and language competencies)
- 2: Credits based on the interview in English in front of a jury

Successful candidates will be informed individually (by mail and/or email) and must confirm their registration. The master programme for the second cohort will start in September 2013 as part of the Summer School. We wish all candidates good luck for their application!
