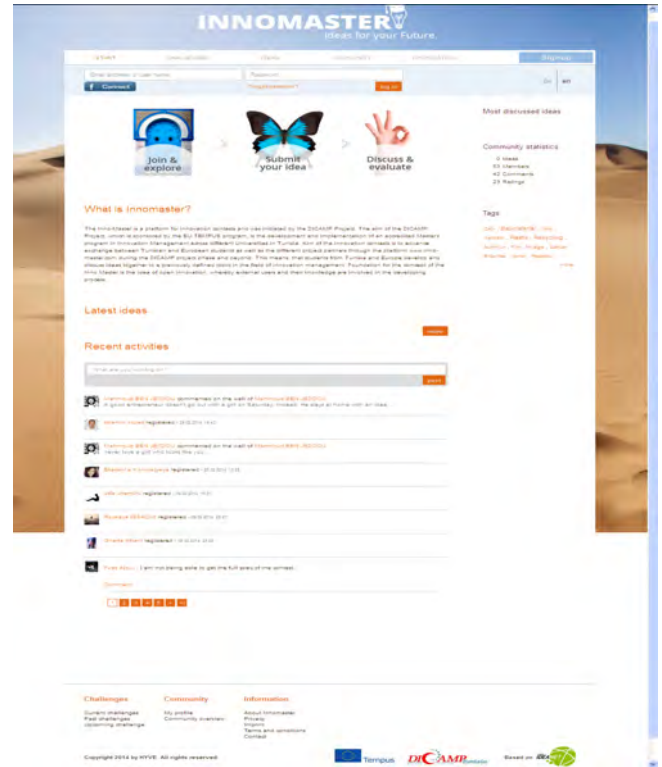




## Project Activities
