Dicamp new students 2014

After publishing the call for applications in local newspapers and on the universities' websites, 748 applications were sent to ENIT until the closing of the call in June 2014. The jury invited 103 candidates for the interviews which were done in July 2014. The new & third cohort of DICAMP students consists again of 30 qualified persons who will be officially enrolled into the programme in September 2014. In this cohort we have 17 female and 13 male students. Their backgrounds are balanced; 15 students are from Business and Management and 15 are from Technical Studies. 10 of the students are already working in companies and 20 of the students just graduated.

## Project Activities

DICAMP Innovation Lab @ ENIT

Our project partner Fraunhofer MOEZ was responsible to develop and implement an Innovation Lab. Together with the students Ezzedine Ben Rhima, Mahmoud Ben Jeddou and Abdelmonam Kouka as well as the ENIT teacher Helmi Ben Rejeb they created a concept for the innovation lab which follows the basic principles of the innovation process. The lab will be divided into three compartments: Idea Searching, Idea Prioritization and Idea Implementation. ENIT provided two rooms for realizing the Innovation Lab: one room will be an Open Space for Idea Searching and Idea Prioritization and another will be used for Idea Implementation, which is equipped with modern laptops funded by the EU Tempus programme. A special thanks goes to Ezzedine Ben Rhima who sponsored a new floor for the lab from his own money. Our Innovation Lab is now ready to use and equipped with laptops, flipcharts, posters and other technical things.
