ASIIN Feedback

In the beginning of October 2014 ASIIN sent their feedback to our accreditation report and the on-site visit. The feedback was mainly positive but we still need to fulfill some requirements. Currently European partners and the Tunisian universities ENIT, ESSEC and IHEC are working on these requirements to further improve the programme. They have to be fulfilled before June 2015 in order to accredit the master programme and to carry the ASIIN seal until 2019.

Extension of the Project Duration

Due to the given requirements for the accreditation of our master programme the project coordinator asked the EU Tempus coordinator for an cost neutral extension of the DICAMP project. Since ASIIN sent their feedback at the beginning of October and the official end of our project will be 14 October 2014, there was not enough time to fulfill the requirements. Thanks to Tempus who accepted our request for an extension. Now the project is officially over on 14 April 2015.
