



## Project Activities

EU partners' workshop in Paris

EU partners met from 14th - October 16th to discuss the two past project years and focus on the final commitments. In doing so, they analyzed students' evaluation from the courses that have been done in Europe. Based on the results of the student's feedback of the courses EU partners worked on guidelines to improve the teaching and coordination of the master programme in Tunisia. Also the evaluation from the project works done in Europe led to a productive strategy for the coordination and organization for the student's stay in Europe for their master theses. Also an activity plan regarding the international accreditation was prepared including the decision on the individual roles of all partners (more details see article below). Regarding the DICAMP project EU partners created a development action plan for the last project year including the brainstorming of some ideas for a sustainability strategy. Those results will be presented to and discussed with Tunisian partners in the project workshop (3. year) in Paris in December 2013.

Accreditation Workshop in Tunis

ASIIN e.V. is a non-profit association for the accreditation of degree programmes in engineering, informatics, natural sciences and mathematics. It is supported by many organisations and it follows European (Bologna Process) as well as international standards of higher education. ASIIN will be responsible for the accreditation of our master programme Innovation Management which process went further in November. From 13-19 of November Anna Trifilova together with partners from Fraunhofer MOEZ and HHL went to Tunis for writing in detail the accreditation report. In order to work very focused and concentrated they met with Tunisian partners from ENIT, ESSEC and IHEC in a hotel in Hammamet from 15-17 of November. The weekend was very productive and each university implemented their parts into the report according to ASIIN criteria. Therefore different parts of the report have been finished as well as tasks and responsibilities have been allocated to partners on specific contents like quality management, specific content of modules (Module Handbook) or information about teachers within the programme (Staff Handbook). We will keep you updated on the status of the accreditation.
